If candidate is interested in applying they should fill out application and submit online. They have 30 days after an electronic application has been submitted to forward the remainder of the necessary paperwork and test (reading and math comprehension proctored and provided at no cost) at the local SIU Hall or your application will be VOID and you cannot reapply. Applicants must be 18 years of age or older. Consideration should be given to the costs related to the testing, credentials, dental work, uniforms, and transportation expenses for admittance to the school. If there is concern regarding whether a candidate has a past indiscretion (recent DUI, drug conviction, violent felony, etc.) that would likely be a concern to the U.S. Coast Guard they can seek an informal opinion by contacting the USCG REC.

If the application is accepted the applicant will be notified by the school. Upon this confirmation they should begin to apply for necessary paperwork and can consult with local SIU hall personnel for guidance
