

INTERNSHIPS AVAILABLE WITH THE USDA FOREST SERVICE

If you are interested in an internship with the US Forest Service for the summer 2017 this is your chance!!

The Forest Service has partnered with the Greening Youth Foundation to provide paid internships for Native American college students with Forest Service units nationwide.(limited number of positions available)

Requirements: Must be able to work 10 weeks, 40 hours per week during the summer.

Preferably live within driving distance of a National Forest unit (not always necessary).

Must be enrolled at a minimum half time.

Must have a GPA of 2.0 or better and be in good academic standing.

Students earn \$10. per hour, work a 40 hour work week, and receive a \$40. per pay period stipend to assist with daily travel to the work site.
